irrigation	moving water to a place that needs it teamwork; one person oversaw work dam will hold back water dam gates will open during dry season important in creating early communities
Settled life pros i. surplus	more food meant more children meant pop. increase <u>Food year round</u> didn't have to make as much

Settled Life : Settlements grew into towns

Surplus → people could do things other than producing food all day

Some chose occupations (job specialization)

artisan : skilled craftworker
Such as:
baskets, leather goods, tools, pottery, cloth

Growth of cities : cities developed along rivers

rivers: → transportation, fertile soil, water, food

Comparison of cities to farming villages

point-to-point comparison

C: larger, public bldgs
bldgs for surplus, worship, buy & sell goods, occupation.
was mainly artisans
wide variety of occupations

S.v.: smaller, no public bldg., no bldgs for surplus, main occupation was farming
