Old Stone Age vs New Stone Age

Similarities: stone tools, hunted wild animals, weapons, ate plants, OSA worked in groups, (cooperatively), NSA traded (both types of cooperation)

NSA: farmers, settled less nomadic, domestication of dogs, horses, camels, cattle, food surplus, increase in population, developed villages and cities, social classes, more sophisticated tools

population: increased, people could stay in one place -> cities developed -> different occupations developed -> artisans -> trade between artisans and farmers
