- natural resource: anything from nat. environment that people use to meet their needs

examples: fertile soil, clean water, human labor & skills, energy sources, minerals, trees

Renewable resources: resource that can be replaced naturally or fairly quickly

examples: lumber, (forests), plants, animals, rich soil, grasslands

Non-renewable resources: resources that cannot be replaced quickly

↳ big example: fossil fuels: formed by geologic forces; depend on these for energy
