## Lesson 12.1

Rush Bagot: limited naval power of Brit. & U.S. on Great Lakes

Convention of 1818: gave U.S. fishing rights off Newfoundland & Labrador coasts, established border between U.S. & Canada @ 49<sup>th</sup> par.  
Both countries agreed to joint occupation of Pacific Northwest

Adams - Onis: Between Spain & U.S.

- Spain gave Fla to U.S.
- U.S. gave up claims to Texas
- U.S. assumed \$5.0M of Spanish debt to U.S. citizens

# Monroe Doctrine:

- Pres. Monroe declared that North & South America were OFF LIMITS to future colonization of any foreign power
- Declared that any attempts to interfere with L. A.'s independence to be a hostile act
