STUDENTS

- ◆ Students consistently outperform the national average on standardized tests; all grades score above the 90th percentile nationally on Iowa Tests.

ACADEMICS/CURRICULUM

- ◆ Full-Day kindergarten
- ◆ K-8 state required classes and religion, foreign language, music, drama, physical education
- ◆ Technology-based learning throughout the curriculum

FAITH, CHARACTER AND LEADERSHIP

Students participate in daily prayer, attend and organize weekly mass, and take part in parish and community service opportunities.

TECHNOLOGY

- ◆ Apple Mac Computer lab, classroom Mac Desktops, wireless MacBooks and supporting software and hardware.
- ◆ All classrooms equipped with SMARTBoards for internet and interactive learning.
- ◆ Mobile MacBooks used by grades 4 through 8
- ◆ Broadcast equipment used by Junior High
- ◆ Computer lab used by all classes two to three times per week.
- ◆ Students learn computer basics, internet navigation and research, and are skilled in using both Apples iWorks and Microsoft Office.

- ◆ Learning disabilities services, psychologist, speech & language pathologist, remedial reading & math tutors
